Notes to net control stations:

Remember to state your call sign at intervals of no more than ten minutes. If the net runs slow, insert your call as needed.

Good evening, everyone! It's 7:45 PM and it's time for the North Hills Radio Club 2 meter Pre-net to the Sacramento Saturday Evening 75 meter net. The purpose of the 75 meter net is to encourage HF radio operating for club members and other Amateurs. This net is a service of the North Hills Radio Club and is open to all licensed radio operators wishing to participate. The mode is Lower side band, and tonight's host over on HF will likely check in as we go along.

Now we will start check-ins for anyone that wishes to join us. It is not necessary to be a member. Also, you can check in here even if you are not joining the net on HF.

Call sign suffix, Juliet to Quebec, please check in now. (Pause) (Acknowledge) (Repeat)

Call sign suffix, Romeo to Zulu, please check in now. (Pause) (Acknowledge) (Repeat)

Any other stations, please check in now. (Pause) (Acknowledge) (Repeat)

Any other comments or questions for the net tonight, please come now (Acknowledge any traffic)

Thanks again for joining us tonight.

The 75 meter net meets on 3918.5 KHz, at 8:00 PM, every Saturday following this net. Everyone is encouraged to QSY, and anyone with a general class or higher license is welcome to check in.
